Going for Gold

Our children and staff go for gold in all areas of school life: learning, teaching and behaviour. All teachers lead a subject area and engage in continuous improvement of this area. This includes attending CPD, delivering relevant CPD to staff, engaging with children and monitoring subject delivery and standards. All staff work together to continue to develop their own practice and are given time to do this.

We use RWI Phonics and are currently working with a local English Hub to ensure consistency of practice and delivery in Early Reading.

Our children are enthusiastic learners who enjoy seeing their own success. They are keen to improve and make progress across the curriculum. Our two-year-olds settle and develop quickly, making good relationships with staff and investigating the world around them. Our Nursery class attends every morning and the children quickly engage with their environment. Children's progress is recorded, assessed and then future learning planned using Tapestry. Nursery children experience transition into school at the beginning of the academic year and then further transition into Reception at the end of the year.

Our child-centred approach ensures every child makes progress and the vast majority reach GLD at the end of Reception.
