Childcare Arrangements for Key Worker Parent/Carers

Dear Families,

From Monday 23rd March until Friday 3rd April schools will remain open to provide childcare for parents or carers that are on the key worker list recommended by the government. These families have now provided us with details which we can verify and then plan our staffing levels. Therefore PHP will be open from 8:40am until 3:15pm.

Children who are eligible for a Free School Meal can still order one and collect it from school. It will be a packed lunch made up of a cheese or ham sandwich, a piece of fruit and a cookie or a cake. To ensure your child gets their meal, please order today by messaging Miss Gunter directly on Class Dojo. She will then place the order on Monday morning. Orders cannot be placed after 9:00. You will be able to collect the meal from the front office.

If your child is offered a place at our reduced provision, they can order a meal at school following the usual procedures. If your child is in YR, Y1 or Y2 and not eligible for Free School Meals then you will need to pay for a cooked meal. All children who attend are alternatively welcome to bring a packed lunch.

Pupils may wear their own clothes suitable for physical and creative activities that will take place throughout the day. Nursery pupils session time will be from 9:00am until 11:45am. Nursery pupils do not need to bring in a packed lunch due to the time of their session. Children should be brought to and collected from the front office.

We all remain understanding of the seriousness and unsettling nature of these events and we would remind families of this advice;

“The Government has asked parents to keep their children at home wherever possible... the fewer children making the journey to school and the fewer children in educational settings the lower the risk that the virus can spread.”

Everyone in our school feels a sense of sadness today and are very uncertain about the future. I hope with these measures and others in place the country is able to contain the virus as quickly as possible and I am able to welcome all our fabulous children back to school as quickly as possible. Any changes to our plans or good news to report will always be displayed on Class Dojo and our school website.
