



Year 2 have also been super scientists this week. They've been investigating different seeds. See what your child can tell you about them at home!






In RE the children have been learning about Jesus. They've then applied what they learnt to create their own stained glass windows. I hope you agree that they have clearly put a lot of effort into their work!






Year 4 have been applying their knowledge of Egypt to their writing. Here's Ava-Grace's wonderfully persuasive travel brochure!








Year 5 have also been scientists this week! They've begun an experiment into the effectiveness of handwashing using different products. The results will be revealed in about 4 weeks!
