Below are challenges for the different areas of learning that you can complete with your child in order to prepare them for Nursery in September 2020.

These are suggested activities please complete at your own pace.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development Challenges

Make dens from sheets and blankets that I can play in with you or my friends.

Make a box with different things in it, like glue and different types of paper, which I can choose from when I am making a picture or model from boxes.

Talk to me about the order I need to do things in, like brushing my teeth or getting ready for bed.

To start to tidy up their own activities when they have finished.

To start to use the toilet on my own.



Communication and Language Listening and attention

Use sock puppets or toy people or animals when you are sharing one of my favourite stories or songs with me.

When we are making a sandwich together, tell me what you are doing so I know what to do.

When we are playing with things, use new words to describe what I am doing with them or to tell me what they are called.

Sing many Nursery rhymes. Please find the link on the school website.

Share many stories with me.

Physical Development

Play ball games with me.

Give me many ribbons that I can wave around me.

Let me try to dress my teddy or doll with different types of clothes, like coats, jumpers and dresses, and different types of fastenings, like buttons and zips. Let me help get lunch ready by cutting the cheese or bananas.
